- Research Organizer completed for a grade

4. Create a POSTER

- Create a poster that showcases the information you researched. Poster must include:
 - Artist's Name in large letters
 - Art movement(s) artist participated in
 - Description of art movement characteristics
 - Description of artist's style (how they made artwork)
 - At least 3 examples of artist's work
 - Image of artwork
 - Title, dimensions, and date of artwork
 - Description of artwork's significance
 - Organize/Decorate poster in a style that mimics the artist's/movement's style!
