 - Movement's title in large letters
 - o Significant Artists from the movement
 - Description of art movement characteristics
 - At least 4 examples of artist's work from time period
 - Image of artwork
 - Title, dimensions, and date of artwork
 - Description of artwork's significance
 - Organize/Decorate poster in a style that mimics the movement's style!
